HOW MANY JUMPS?

Mark a starting point.

Jump as far as you can and mark where you land, you can try 3 times and take your biggest jump. Get Mummy or Daddy to measure the distance, mark that spot and put your name on that spot.

How far can you jump? _____ cm's.

How far can a grasshopper jump?

1.5 metres! Get Mummy or Daddy to measure 1.5 metres and mark the spot for the grasshopper.

What about a frog?

A frog can jump up to 1.9 metres! Measure this out too and mark the frog's spot.

And the most amazing jumper, is from my country Australia. How far do you think a kangaroo can jump?

4.5 metres!!! Wow that's so far. Mummy or Daddy might need a tape measure for that, they are such far jumpers. Measure this spot and mark it.

Now, starting from the starting mark, see how many jumps it takes you to jump as far as the grasshopper, frog, and kangaroo.

You can also work it out by taking your first jump and using the tape measure to count how many jumps are from the start to each animal.

Once you finish this project, you can download the document Da Vinci's Virtruvian Man and measure your body. You might find so many different parts of your body are the exact same measurement!
